## **Electric Aggregation Program Update for Village of Frankfort**

At the September 5, 2017 Village board meeting, Village officials announced the Will Electric Aggregation Group through the Will County Governmental League, provided an option for the Village of Frankfort for the electric aggregation program. Homefield Energy-Dynegy is an approved alternative to Com Ed as a supplier for Frankfort's electric aggregation program for one year, effective October 1, 2017. On August 24, 2017, after a thorough review, the Will Electric Aggregation Group approved a contract with Homefield Energy-Dynegy as the supplier for the consortium of over 17 Will County communities. Frankfort is part of that consortium.

The one year deal provides a fixed rate of \$.07190/kWh; Com Ed's price will be \$.07276/kWh effective October 1, 2017. This is a 1% savings over Com Ed rates. This rate only applies to the supply portion of an electric bill.

In the next few weeks, eligible residential and small business customers will receive a notice from their municipality and Homefield Energy-Dynegy which will state the offer and provide instructions for opting-out of the program, if desired. Customers wishing to participate in the program will not need to take any action to be included. You will continue to receive a bill from ComEd under this program.

Your account will be automatically enrolled in the program unless you choose to opt-out; there is no penalty.

Residents and small businesses may receive solicitations from other suppliers over the next few weeks to switch their account. If a notice is not explicitly marked as being from their municipality, Homefield Energy-Dynegy, or ComEd, customers should assume it is not connected to the electrical aggregation program.

"The Village of Frankfort will continue to work with the Will Electric Aggregation Group to provide the best rates for our community. Through this program, our residents have the opportunity to join or opt out without penalties," commented Mayor Jim Holland.
