

Information About Your New Sewer Fees

On March 21, 2016, the Village of Frankfort approved an ordinance authorizing the use of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) funding to finance the implementation of the Village's 20-year Facility Plan (adopted in the Fall of 2015). The plan includes converting the north wastewater treatment facility into a pumping station. This component of the project is specific to your area. The total plan provides the necessary updates to adhere to compliance standards issued by the Illinois and United States Environmental Protection Agencies, to satisfy future growth needs, and to eliminate aging facilities. The multi-year project is estimated to cost \$61 million.

On June 19, 2017, the Village approved a sewer rate increase of \$1.59 per 1,000 gallons effective September 1, 2017 and an additional increase of \$1.59 per 1,000 gallons effective September 1, 2018 (the current sewer rate is \$4.98 per 1,000 gallons) to meet loan obligations. The rate increases to date, including these mentioned, will fund the repayment of six of the seven project phases. The new rates are reflected in the following table:
