Village of Frankfort Seeks Village Clerk

The Village of Frankfort is accepting applications for Village Clerk. Adam Borrelli, the current Village Clerk, was appointed in 2015 and elected to office in 2017. Clerk Borrelli recently ran and won a Village Trustee seat on April 2, 2019. As such, He submitted his resignation as Village Clerk effective April 30, 2019. The Village Clerk term expires on April 30, 2021.

The Village Clerk is an elected Board position. The Clerk attends all Village Board meetings, including executive sessions, and keeps a full record of the proceedings in the form of minutes. The Clerk is the official keeper of the Village Seal.

When a vacancy occurs during an unexpired term, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/3.1-20-5, The Mayor appoints the Village Clerk with the advice and consent of the Trustees.

Mayor Jim Holland and the Board of Trustees invite residents of Frankfort to submit applications to be considered for the Village Clerk appointment.
